Homebound Holy Communion

Principle: Holy Communion is the sacrament that sustains and nourishes us in our journey of faith and salvation, therefore the church must intentionally concern itself about those who are absent from the Lord's Table.

Purpose: To extend the Lord's Table, serving the sacrament of Holy Communion to all members of our worship community who are unable to attend church worship services, due to physical and/or health constraints.

Goal: On the first Sunday of each month when Holy Communion is celebrated by the church congregation, laity in two person teams will take the prepared and consecrated elements of Holy Communion to serve homebound members within two(2) days after Holy Communion has been celebrated by the congregation. Further, the stewards will either read the scripture for the day and give a brief summary of the sermon or read the "Christ In Our Home" devotion for that particular day with the recipient.
